DEMOCRATIC PARTY (DP) PROPOSAL

NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COMPETENCIES

The National Executive may issue directions, in terms of national legislation passed with the consent of the NCOP, to the executive of a province when such directive is necessary for: -

(a), (b), (c) (d)

Provincial governments shall comply with such directions.

Should any shortcomings in the implementations of such directions be identified by the National Executive the NCOP shall decide at the request of the National Executive or the Province concerned whether the Province is in breach of the law.

The decision of the NCOP may be appealed from in the Constitutional Court.
